1 (b) CLASSIFIED ANNEXES.—The report required 2 under subsection (a) may be accompanied by classified an-3 nexes if necessary, except that the Secretary of State is 4 encouraged to provide as much information as possible in 5 unclassified format.

6 (c) RECOMMENDATIONS.—Not later than 180 days
7 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
8 of State shall provide to Congress classified recommenda9 tions relating to the following:

10 (1) How the United States can best counter11 Chinese information operations.

12 (2) How the United States can best mitigate
13 Chinese coercive measures related to sustaining the
14 Chinese narrative.

(3) How the United States can best penetrate
areas of Chinese information operations dominance.
(4) How the United States can provide the citizens of the People's Republic of China with information that is not controlled by Chinese Communist
Party censors.
