At the end of subtitle B of title X, insert the following:

## 1 SEC. 10\_\_\_\_. REPORT ON DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE OPER 2 ATIONAL PLANNING TO DEFEAT MEXICAN 3 DRUG CARTELS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the 5 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense, in consultation with the heads of such other depart-6 ments and agencies as the Secretary determines appro-7 priate, shall submit to the appropriate congressional com-8 9 mittees a report on Department of Defense operational planning to defeat Mexican drug cartels. Such report shall 10 11 include the following elements:

- 12 (1) A history of Mexican military operations
  13 against transnational criminal organizations, includ14 ing—
- 15 (A) areas of operations;
- 16 (B) operations against high value targets;17 and,

18 (C) after-action reviews of operations.

1	(2) An assessment of Mexican military assets
2	and capabilities, including—
3	(A) unit-specific leadership assessments;
4	(B) unit-specific strengths;
5	(C) unit-specific weaknesses;
6	(D) unit-specific readiness; and,
7	(E) unit-specific susceptibility to corrup-
8	tion or cooperation with transnational criminal
9	organizations.
10	(3) An identification of any gaps in Mexican
11	military assets and capabilities for which the United
12	States Armed Forces could provide additional re-
13	sources to assist in the defeat of Mexican drug car-
14	tels.
15	(4) A description of operational plans to mili-
16	tarily defeat Mexican drug cartels with varying levels
17	of coordination and cooperation with the Mexican
18	military.
19	(5) An assessment of additional steps that
20	would be necessary to secure a military victory after
21	the military defeat of such cartels.
22	(b) FORM OF REPORT.—The report required under
23	subsection (a) shall be submitted in classified form.

(c) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES.—
 In this section the term "appropriate congressional com mittees" means—

4 (1) the congressional defense committee;

5 (2) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and the
6 Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence of the
7 House of Representatives; and

8 (3) the Committee on Foreign Relations and9 the Select Committee on Intelligence of the Senate.
