

**AMENDMENT TO CONSOLIDATED
APPROPRIATIONS ACT, 2026
OFFERED BY MR. CROW OF COLORADO**

At the end of division A (before the short title), insert the following:

1 SEC. _____. (a) None of the funds made available by
2 this division may be obligated or expended until the date
3 on which the Secretary of Defense submits to the congres-
4 sional defense committees a report on Operation Southern
5 Spear that includes—
6 (1) a full accounting of the operation;
7 (2) identification of the Armed Forces of the
8 United States involved in the operation;
9 (3) a detailed accounting of any funds of the
10 Department of Defense obligated or expended for
11 the operation, including for—
12 (A) personnel costs, including costs for—
13 (i) active duty, reserve, and National
14 Guard pay and benefits;
15 (ii) special pay, bonuses, and tem-
16 porary duty; and
17 (iii) the use of involuntary mobiliza-
18 tions;

(B) operation and maintenance costs, including costs for—

3 (i) fuel, transportation, maintenance,
4 logistics, and base operating support;

5 (ii) intelligence, surveillance and re-
6 connaissance; and

7 (iii) communications support;

8 (C) procurement costs, including costs
9 for—

10 (i) weapon systems, vehicles, and
11 equipment;

12 (ii) munitions:

13 (iii) weapons expended:

14 (iv) replacement and replenishment
15 costs; and

16 (v) the use of presidential drawdown
17 authority (PDA):

18 (D) military construction or facility up-
19 grade costs;

20 (E) contractor support costs, including
21 the cost of insurance, travel, and local support

22 and an explanation of—
23 (i) the word *convention* is used

24 (ii) the functions performed by con-
25 tractors; and

1 (iii) contract values by service and lo-
2 cation; and
3 (F) readiness and sustainment costs, in-
4 cluding costs for—
5 (i) flying hours and steaming days;
6 (ii) equipment wear and tear;
7 (iii) deferred maintenance or readi-
8 ness tradeoffs; and
9 (iv) reset and depot maintenance
10 costs.

11 (b) In this section, the term “congressional defense
12 committees” has the meaning given that term in section
13 101(a)(16) of title 10, United States Code.
