## AMENDMENT TO

## Rules Committee Print 118–36 Offered by Mr. Crow of Colorado

At the end of subtitle C of title V, add the following:

## 1 SEC. 5\_\_\_\_. REASSIGNMENT FOR CERTAIN MEMBERS OF 2 THE ARMED FORCES ON THE BASIS OF THE 3 RESIDENCE OF A DEPENDENT CHILD.

Chapter 39 of title 10, United States Code, is amended by inserting, after item 674, the following new section: **6 "§675. Permanent change of station or unit transfer**for a member on active duty on the basis
of the residence of a dependent child

9 "(a) TIMELY CONSIDERATION AND ACTION.—(1) A
10 commanding officer shall determine whether to grant a re11 quest for a covered reassignment not later than five cal12 endar days after the covered member makes such request.
13 "(2) If a commanding officer denies a request under

paragraph (1), the covered member may request review
of such denial by the first general officer or flag officer
in the chain of command of the covered member. Such
general officer or flag officer shall determine whether to
affirm or reverse such denial not later than 2 weeks after
the covered member makes such request.

"(b) REGULATIONS.—The Secretary of Defense shall
 prescribe regulations to ensure that this section is carried
 out as uniformly as possible across the military depart ments.

5 "(c) PRIVACY.—A commanding officer shall, to the
6 greatest extent practicable, protect the privacy of a cov7 ered member who requests a covered reassignment.

8 "(d) PROHIBITION.—No covered member may be
9 subject to any adverse action for requesting a covered re10 assignment.

11 "(e) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

"(1) The term 'covered child' means a dependent child of a member of the armed forces who is
registered under the Defense Enrollment Eligibility
Reporting System (or successor system).

- 16 "(2) The term 'covered member' means a mem17 ber—
- 18 "(A) serving on active duty;
- 19 "(B) who has a covered child; and

20 "(C) assigned to a duty station located
21 more than 300 miles from the residence of such
22 covered child.

23 "(3) The term 'covered reassignment' means a
24 request—

25 "(A) by a covered member; and

"(B) for a permanent change of station, or
 a unit transfer, to a duty station located within
 300 miles of the residence of the covered child
 of such covered member.".
