## 1 SEC. 9510. SAFE CROSS BORDER OPERATIONS.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 201 of
3 title 49, United States Code, is amended by adding at the
4 end the following:

## 5 "SEC. 20174. CREW REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAINS ORIGI6 NATING IN OR DESTINED TO MEXICO.

"(a) Trains originating in or destined to Mexico may
be operated for distances of 20 air-miles or fewer from
the intersection of the international border and the existing rail border crossing or rail gateway only by crews comprised of persons that are either a citizen or lawful permanent resident of the United States, or that meet all of the
following requirements:

"(1) Have current Mexican passports and B1/
B2 visas and have been granted clearance by U.S.
Customs and Border Protection under the Free and
Secure Trade Program (FAST), or other trusted

1	traveler/trusted shipper program administered by the
2	Department of Homeland Security.

3 "(2) Are licensed by the Mexican government to
4 operate trains in Mexico.

5 "(3) Are certified under locomotive engineer or
6 conductor certification programs filed with the U.S.
7 Federal Railroad Administration under parts 240
8 and 242 of title 49, Code of Federal Regulations.

9 "(4) Comply with United States hours of serv10 ice requirements in chapter 211 of title 49, United
11 States Code.

12 "(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) above, no train 13 originating in or destined to Mexico may be operated in 14 the United States for distances in excess of 20 air-miles 15 from the intersection of the international border and the 16 existing rail border crossing or rail gateway, unless by 17 crews comprised entirely of citizens or lawful permanent 18 residents of the United States.".

(b) REGULATIONS REQUIRED.—Not later than 180
days after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary
of Transportation shall issue such regulations as are necessary to carry out the amendments made by this Act.
(c) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
for subchapter II of chapter 201 of title 49, United States
Code, is amended by adding at the end the following:

"Sec. 20174. Crew requirements for trains originating in or destined to mexico.".
