

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT**  
**112-25 FOR H.R. 2578**  
**OFFERED BY MR. CUELLAR OF TEXAS**

After section 403, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 404. BOUNDARY STUDY.**

2 Section 201 of Public Law 95-629 (16 U.S.C. 410ee)  
3 is amended—

4 (1) by redesignating subsections (b), (c), (d),  
5 (e), and (f) as subsections (c), (e), (f), (g), and (h)  
6 respectively; and

7 (2) by inserting after subsection (a) the fol-  
8 lowing new subsection:

9 “(b)(1) The Secretary shall—

10 “(A) conduct a study of lands within Bexar and  
11 Wilson Counties, Texas, to identify lands that would  
12 be suitable for inclusion within the boundaries of the  
13 park;

14 “(B) in conducting the study, examine the nat-  
15 ural, cultural, recreational, and scenic values and  
16 characteristics of lands within Bexar and Wilson  
17 Counties;

18 “(C) examine and include in the study an esti-  
19 mate of the costs the Federal Government is ex-

1       pected to incur, such as estimates of funding needed  
2       to acquire additional land, and the amount of addi-  
3       tional funding that the Secretary anticipates will be  
4       needed to operate the San Antonio Missions Na-  
5       tional Historical Park should the land identified in  
6       the study be acquired;

7               “(D) examine and denote in the study those  
8       lands in Bexar and Wilson Counties, Texas, that the  
9       Secretary has good reason to believe could be ac-  
10      quired by donation; and

11              “(E) conduct this study—

12                      “(i) using existing appropriated funds  
13                      when available; or

14                      “(ii) accepting funding from local public  
15                      entities to conduct aforementioned study.

16      “(2) Not later than 3 years after the date funds are  
17      made available for the study under paragraph (1), the Sec-  
18      retary shall submit to the Committee on Natural Re-  
19      sources of the House of Representatives and the Com-  
20      mittee on Energy and Natural Resources of the Senate  
21      a report on the findings, conclusions, and recommenda-  
22      tions of the study.”.
