

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-**  
**19**  
**OFFERED BY MR. CUNNINGHAM OF SOUTH**  
**CAROLINA**

Add at the end of subtitle B of title V the following:

1 **SEC. 5\_\_\_ . PILOT PROGRAM ON THE JUNIOR RESERVE OF-**  
2 **FICERS' TRAINING CORPS PROGRAM AT LUCY**  
3 **GARRETT BECKHAM HIGH SCHOOL,**  
4 **CHARLESTON COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the department  
6 in which the Coast Guard is operating may carry out a  
7 pilot program to establish and maintain a Junior Reserve  
8 Officers' Training Corps (JROTC) program unit in co-  
9 operation with Lucy Garrett Beckham High School,  
10 Charleston County, South Carolina.

11 (b) PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS.—The pilot program  
12 carried out by the Secretary under this section shall pro-  
13 vide to students at Lucy Garrett Beckham High School—

14 (1) instruction in subject areas relating to oper-  
15 ations of the Coast Guard; and

16 (2) training in skills which are useful and ap-  
17 propriate for a career in the Coast Guard.

1 (c) PROVISION OF ADDITIONAL SUPPORT.—In car-  
2 rying out the pilot program under this section, the Sec-  
3 retary may provide to Lucy Garrett Beckham High  
4 School—

5 (1) assistance in course development, instruc-  
6 tion, and other support activities; and

7 (2) necessary and appropriate course materials,  
8 equipment, and uniforms.

9 (d) EMPLOYMENT OF RETIRED COAST GUARD PER-  
10 SONNEL.—

11 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to paragraph (2),  
12 the Secretary may authorize the Lucy Garrett  
13 Beckham High School to employ, as administrators  
14 and instructors for the pilot program, retired Coast  
15 Guard and Coast Guard Reserve commissioned, war-  
16 rant, and petty officers not on active duty who re-  
17 quest that employment and who are approved by the  
18 Secretary and Lucy Garrett Beckham High School.

19 (2) AUTHORIZED PAY.—

20 (A) IN GENERAL.—Retired members em-  
21 ployed under paragraph (1) are entitled to re-  
22 ceive their retired or retainer pay and an addi-  
23 tional amount of not more than the difference  
24 between—

1 (i) the amount the individual would be  
2 paid as pay and allowance if the individual  
3 was considered to have been ordered to ac-  
4 tive duty during the period of employment;  
5 and

6 (ii) the amount of retired pay the in-  
7 dividual is entitled to receive during that  
8 period.

9 (B) PAYMENT TO SCHOOL.—The Secretary  
10 shall pay to Lucy Garrett Beckham High  
11 School an amount equal to one-half of the  
12 amount described in subparagraph (A), from  
13 funds appropriated for such purpose.

14 (3) EMPLOYMENT NOT ACTIVE-DUTY OR INAC-  
15 TIVE-DUTY TRAINING.—Notwithstanding any other  
16 provision of law, while employed under this sub-  
17 section, an individual is not considered to be on ac-  
18 tive-duty or inactive-duty training.
