## **AMENDMENT TO**

## RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118-10 OFFERED BY MR. CURTIS OF UTAH

At the end of subtitle C of title XV, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 15 REPORT ON INFORMATION OPERATIONS CAPA-
2	BILITIES OF RUSSIA.
3	(a) Sense of Congress.—It is the sense of the Con-
4	gress that the effectiveness of the information operations
5	capabilities of Russia poses a threat not only to the oper-
6	ations of the United States, but to those of the allies and
7	partners of the United States.
8	(b) Report.—Not later than 180 days after the date
9	of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense, in co-
10	ordination with the Secretary of State and the Director
11	of National Intelligence, shall submit to the appropriate
12	congressional committees a report containing the fol-
13	lowing:
14	(1) An assessment of the information oper-
15	ations capabilities of Russia, including attributable,
16	non-attributable, and deliberately misleading sources
17	in and related to Ukraine.

1	(2) An assessment of the efforts taken by the
2	Secretary of Defense, and by the information oper-
3	ations components of the armed forces of partners
4	and allies of the United States, to target and other-
5	wise coordinate efforts against Russian military in-
6	formation operations.
7	(c) FORM.—The report under subsection (b) shall be
8	submitted in unclassified form, but may include a classi-
9	fied annex.
10	(d) Appropriate Congressional Committees
11	DEFINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate con-
12	gressional committees" means—
13	(1) the congressional defense committees;
14	(2) the Permanent Select Committee on Intel-
15	ligence of the House of Representatives; and
16	(3) the Select Committee on Intelligence of the
17	Senate.
