

**AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118-36
OFFERED BY MR. CURTIS OF UTAH**

Page 732, after line 3, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 17_. REPORT BY SECRETARY OF COMMERCE ON RE-**
2 **QUESTS FROM GOVERNMENT OF HONG KONG**
3 **TO UNITED STATES COMPANIES FOR CON-**
4 **SUMER INFORMATION, CONTENT TAKE-**
5 **DOWNS, OR LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
7 date of the enactment of this Act, and every 180 days
8 thereafter, the Secretary of Commerce, in consultation
9 with the heads of other appropriate Federal departments
10 and agencies, shall submit to the appropriate congress-
11 sional committees and make available to the public a re-
12 port on—

13 (1) the protection of consumer information in
14 the possession of United States companies operating
15 in Hong Kong; and

16 (2) requests issued by the Government of Hong
17 Kong to United States companies operating in Hong

1 Kong for content takedowns or law enforcement as-
2 sistance.

3 (b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The report re-
4 quired by subsection (a) shall, with respect to the 180-
5 day period preceding the date of submission of the report,
6 include the following:

7 (1) The number of requests, issued by the Gov-
8 ernment of Hong Kong to United States companies
9 operating in Hong Kong for consumer information
10 in the possession of such companies, content take-
11 downs, or law enforcement assistance, that were ful-
12 filled and by which companies.

13 (2) An identification of the Hong Kong laws
14 under which such requests were issued.

15 (3) An identification of any United States con-
16 sumer protection laws that may have been violated
17 in the case of the fulfillment of such requests by
18 such companies.

19 (c) FORM OF REPORT.—The report required by sub-
20 section (a) shall be submitted in unclassified form, but
21 may include a classified annex.

22 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

23 (1) The term “appropriate congressional com-
24 mittees” means—

1 (A) the Committee on Commerce, Science,
2 and Transportation, the Committee on Foreign
3 Relations, the Committee on Banking, Housing,
4 and Urban Affairs, the Committee on Finance,
5 and the Select Committee on Intelligence of the
6 Senate; and

7 (B) the Committee on Energy and Com-
8 merce, the Committee on Foreign Affairs, the
9 Committee on Financial Services, the Perma-
10 nent Select Committee on Intelligence, and the
11 Committee on Ways and Means of the House of
12 Representatives.

13 (2) The term “content takedown” means the
14 removal of, disabling of access to, or restriction of
15 access to any material, including—

16 (A) material on a website or online service;

17 (B) a software application; and

18 (C) any feature of a software application.
