

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118-

10

OFFERED BY MR. CASE OF HAWAII

At the end of subtitle F of title VI, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 6___ . STUDY TO REVIEW WEIGHTED STUDENT UNITS**
2 **FOR IMPACT AID PAYMENTS FOR ELIGIBLE**
3 **FEDERALLY CONNECTED CHILDREN WITH**
4 **DISABILITIES.**

5 (a) STUDY.—The Secretary of Defense, in consulta-
6 tion with the Secretary of Education, shall conduct a
7 study to review the weighted student units used for the
8 calculation of impact aid payments for eligible federally
9 connected children with disabilities under section 7003 of
10 the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20
11 U.S.C. 7703).

12 (b) ELEMENTS.—The study under subsection (a)
13 shall include the following:

14 (1) An explanation of the method used to estab-
15 lish the weighted student units used for the calcula-
16 tion of impact aid payments for eligible federally
17 connected children with disabilities under section

1 7003 of the Elementary and Secondary Education
2 Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7703).

3 (2) A review of the criteria and any special fac-
4 tors used to determine the eligibility of federally con-
5 nected children with disabilities under such section.

6 (3) An examination of the adequacy of the sys-
7 tem used to determined weighted student units for
8 children with disabilities compared to other eligible
9 federally connected children, taking into consider-
10 ation the cost of any support services required.

11 (4) Recommendations for improving the effi-
12 ciency and effectiveness of impact aid payments for
13 eligible federally connected children with disabilities.

14 (c) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date
15 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense
16 shall submit to the congressional defense committees a re-
17 port on the results of the study conducted under sub-
18 section (a).

19 (d) LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCY DEFINED.—In
20 this section, the term “local educational agency” has the
21 meaning given that term in section 7013(9) of the Ele-
22 mentary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.
23 7713(9)).
