**OFFERED BY MS. CLARK OF MASSACHUSETTS**

At the end of title LX, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . SENSE OF CONGRESS ON RECOGNIZING WOMEN**  
2 **IN THE UNITED STATES FOR THEIR SERVICE**  
3 **IN WORLD WAR II AND RECOGNIZING THE**  
4 **ROLE OF REPRESENTATIVE EDITH NOURSE**  
5 **ROGERS IN ESTABLISHING THE WOMEN'S**  
6 **ARMY AUXILIARY CORPS AND THE WOMEN'S**  
7 **ARMY CORPS.**

8 It is the sense of Congress that, on the 79th anniversary  
9 sary of the establishment of the Women's Auxiliary Corps  
10 by Congresswoman Edith Nourse Rogers, the United  
11 States—

12 (1) honors the women who served the United  
13 States in military capacities during World War II;

14 (2) commends those women who, through a  
15 sense of duty and willingness to defy stereotypes and  
16 social pressures, performed military assignments to  
17 aid the war effort, allowing for more combat capacity;

1           (3) recognizes that those women, by serving  
2           with diligence and merit, not only opened up oppor-  
3           tunities for women that had previously been reserved  
4           for men, but also contributed vitally to the victory  
5           of the United States and the Allies in World War II;  
6           and

7           (4) honors the contributions of Congresswoman  
8           Edith Nourse Rogers and her fellow Members of  
9           Congress who supported the establishment of the  
10          Women's Army Auxiliary Corps and the Women's  
11          Army Corps.
