

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 910, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. CONNOLLY OF VIRGINIA**

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **SEC. 5. SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING REGULATION OF**  
2 **POLLUTANTS THAT MAY ENDANGER PUBLIC**  
3 **WELFARE.**

4 It is the sense of Congress that the 1970 Clean Air  
5 Act Amendments directed the Administrator of the Envi-  
6 ronmental Protection Agency to use administrative means  
7 to regulate pollutants “emissions of which, in his judg-  
8 ment, cause or contribute to air pollution which may rea-  
9 sonably be anticipated to endanger public health or wel-  
10 fare,” and that Congress defined “welfare” as including  
11 “effects on soils, water, crops, vegetation, manmade mate-  
12 rials, animals, wildlife, weather, visibility, and climate,  
13 damage to and deterioration of property, and hazards to  
14 transportation, as well as effects on economic values and  
15 on personal comfort and well-being, whether caused by  
16 transformation, conversion, or combination with other air  
17 pollutants.”.
