 (2) SAFETY STUDY.—In carrying out the pilot

program, the Secretary shall conduct a study to determine the impact of the program on commercial
motor vehicle safety.

8 (3) REPORT.—On the date that is 3 years after 9 the date on which the pilot program is established, 10 the Secretary shall submit to Congress a report de-11 scribing the results of the study conducted under 12 paragraph, including a determination of whether the 13 program had a negative impact on safety.

14 (4) TERMINATION.—The pilot program shall
15 terminate upon submission of the report under para16 graph (3) if the report includes a determination that
17 the program had a negative impact on safety.

18 (5) PERMANENT AUTHORITY.—If the report 19 submitted under paragraph (3) does not include a 20 determination that the pilot program had a negative 21 impact on safety, the Secretary shall issue or revise 22 regulations to allow, on a permanent basis, an indi-23 vidual under the age of 21 years to operate a com-24 mercial motor vehicle in accordance with the condi-
