SEC. 513. REPORT ON DIGITAL ASSET TECHNOLOGY USAGE TO ADDRESS HUMANITARIAN NEEDS.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the 4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State, 5 in consultation with the Secretary of the Treasury and the Administrator of the United States Agency for Inter-6 7 national Development, shall submit to the appropriate committees of Congress an unclassified report on the pos-8 9 sible uses of cryptocurrencies or other technologies incor-10 porating blockchains to promote economic development and provide humanitarian aid around the world. 11

(b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The report required under subsection (a) shall also review and analyze
ways in which technologies incorporating blockchains
can—
