

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118-10
OFFERED BY MS. HOULAHAN OF PENNSYLVANIA

Add at the end of subtitle B of title XV the following:

1 **SEC. 1525. POST-GRADUATE EMPLOYMENT OF DEPART-**
2 **MENT OF DEFENSE CYBER AND DIGITAL**
3 **SERVICE ACADEMY SCHOLARSHIP RECIPI-**
4 **ENTS IN INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY.**

5 Section 1535 of the James M. Inhofe National De-
6 fense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2023 (Public Law
7 117-263; 10 U.S.C. 2200 note) is amended—

8 (1) in subsection (a)—

9 (A) in paragraph (1), by inserting “, the
10 heads of the elements of the intelligence com-
11 munity,” after “the Secretary of Homeland Se-
12 curity”; and

13 (B) in paragraph (3), by striking “Depart-
14 ment of Defense Cyber and Digital Service
15 Academy” and inserting “Cyber Service Acad-
16 emy”; and

17 (2) in subsection (d), by inserting “or another
18 element of the intelligence community” after “mis-
19 sions of the Department”.

1 (3) In subsection (e)—

2 (A) by striking “Secretary” each place it
3 appears and inserting “head concerned”; and

4 (B) by inserting “, or within an element of
5 the intelligence community, as the case may be”
6 after “United States Code”;

7 (4) in subsections (h), (j), and (k), by striking
8 “Secretary” and inserting “head concerned” each
9 place it appears; and

10 (5) by adding at the end of the following new
11 subsections:

12 “(p) INTERAGENCY CONSIDERATIONS.—

13 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense
14 shall enter into an agreement with the Director of
15 National Intelligence to allow scholarship recipients
16 who have completed the Program to work for non-
17 Department of Defense elements of the intelligence
18 community if the head of such an element agrees to
19 reimburse the Department of Defense for Program
20 costs associated with such scholarship recipient.

21 “(2) PROHIBITION.—Scholarship recipients who
22 have completed the Program may not serve their
23 post-award employment obligation at an element of
24 the intelligence community outside of the Depart-

1 ment of Defense before an agreement under para-
2 graph (1) is entered into.

3 “(3) LIMITATION.—Not more than fifteen per-
4 cent of scholarship recipients who have completed
5 the Program in each class may be placed in posi-
6 tions with non-Department of Defense elements of
7 the intelligence community unless the Secretary of
8 Defense certifies that the Department of Defense
9 cannot facilitate a placement within the Department.

10 “(q) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

11 “(1) HEAD CONCERNED.—The term ‘head con-
12 cerned’ means—

13 “(A) the Secretary of Defense, with respect
14 to matters concerning the Department of De-
15 fense; or

16 “(B) the head of an element of the intel-
17 ligence community, with respect to matters con-
18 cerning such element.

19 “(2) INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY.—The term
20 ‘intelligence community’ has the meaning given such
21 term in section 3 of the National Security Act of
22 1947 (50 U.S.C. 3003).”.
