

1 (3) ECONOMIC LOSS.—The term “economic
2 loss” means any pecuniary loss resulting from harm
3 (including the loss of earnings or other benefits re-
4 lated to employment, medical expense loss, replace-
5 ment services loss, loss due to death, including sui-
6 cide or any other death that is reasonably attrib-
7 utable to the claimant’s service on January 6, 2021,
8 burial costs, and loss of business or employment op-
9 portunities) to the extent recovery for such loss is al-
10 lowed under applicable State law.

11 (4) ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUAL.—The term “eligible
12 individual” means an individual determined to be eli-
13 gible for compensation under **【section __05(c)】**.

14 (5) NONECONOMIC LOSSES.—The term “non-
15 economic losses” means losses for physical, emo-
16 tional, and psychological pain, suffering, physical im-
17 pairment, mental anguish, post traumatic stress dis-
18 order, disfigurement, loss of enjoyment of life, loss
19 of society and companionship, loss of consortium
20 (other than loss of domestic service), hedonic dam-
21 ages, injury to reputation, and all other nonpecu-
22 niary losses of any kind or nature.

23 (6) SPECIAL MASTER.—The term “Special Mas-
24 ter” means the Special Master appointed under
25 **【section __04(a)】**.

1 **SEC. __03. PURPOSE.**

2 It is the purpose of this title to provide compensation
3 to law enforcement officers who defended the United
4 States Capitol during the events that occurred at or near
5 the United States Capitol on January 6, 2021, and to
6 compensate those officers who were injured, including
7 mental or emotional injury, or who lost their lives as a
8 result of such attack.

9 **SEC. __04. ADMINISTRATION.**

10 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Attorney General, acting
11 through a Special Master appointed by the Attorney Gen-
12 eral, shall—

13 (1) administer the compensation program es-
14 tablished under this title;

15 (2) promulgate all procedural and substantive
16 rules for the administration of this title; and

17 (3) employ and supervise hearing officers and
18 other administrative personnel to perform the duties
19 of the Special Master under this title.

20 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
21 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as may be
22 necessary to pay the administrative and support costs for
23 the Special Master in carrying out this title.

24 **SEC. __05. DETERMINATION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR COM-**
25 **PENSATION.**

26 (a) FILING OF CLAIM.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—A claimant may file a claim
2 for compensation under this title with the Special
3 Master. The claim shall be on the form developed
4 under paragraph (2) and shall state the factual basis
5 for eligibility for compensation and the amount of
6 compensation sought.

7 (2) CLAIM FORM.—

8 (A) IN GENERAL.—The Special Master
9 shall develop a claim form that claimants shall
10 use when submitting claims under paragraph
11 (1). The Special Master shall ensure that such
12 form can be filed electronically, if determined to
13 be practicable.

14 (B) CONTENTS.—The form developed
15 under subparagraph (A) shall request—

16 (i) information from the claimant con-
17 cerning their service as an active duty law
18 enforcement officer in defense of the
19 United States Capitol on January 6, 2021;

20 (ii) information from the claimant
21 concerning the physical, emotional, and
22 psychological harm that the claimant suf-
23 fered, or in the case of a claim filed on be-
24 half of a decedent, information confirming
25 the decedent's death, as a result of the

1 events that occurred at or near the United
2 States Capitol on January 6, 2021, includ-
3 ing suicide or any other death that is rea-
4 sonably attributable to the claimant's serv-
5 ice on January 6, 2021;

6 (iii) information from the claimant
7 concerning any possible economic and non-
8 economic losses that the claimant suffered
9 as a result of such events; and

10 (iv) information regarding collateral
11 sources of compensation the claimant has
12 received or is entitled to receive as a result
13 of such events.

14 (3) LIMITATION.—No claim may be filed under
15 paragraph (1) after the date that is 3 years after
16 the date on which regulations are promulgated
17 under **[section __07]**.

18 (b) REVIEW AND DETERMINATION.—

19 (1) REVIEW.—The Special Master shall review
20 a claim submitted under subsection (a) and deter-
21 mine—

22 (A) whether the claimant is an eligible in-
23 dividual under subsection (c); and

24 (B) with respect to a claimant determined
25 to be an eligible individual—

1 (i) the extent of the harm to the
2 claimant, including any economic and non-
3 economic losses; and

4 (ii) the amount of compensation to
5 which the claimant is entitled based on the
6 harm to the claimant, the facts of the
7 claim, and the individual circumstances of
8 the claimant.

9 (2) NEGLIGENCE.—With respect to a claimant,
10 the Special Master shall not consider negligence or
11 any other theory of liability.

12 (3) DETERMINATION.—Not later than 120 days
13 after that date on which a claim is filed under sub-
14 section (a), the Special Master shall complete a re-
15 view, make a determination, and provide written no-
16 tice to the claimant, with respect to the matters that
17 were the subject of the claim under review. Such a
18 determination shall be final and not subject to judi-
19 cial review.

20 (4) RIGHTS OF CLAIMANT.—A claimant in a re-
21 view under paragraph (1) shall have—

22 (A) the right to be represented by an at-
23 torney;

1 (B) the right to present evidence, including
2 the presentation of witnesses and documents;
3 and

4 (C) any other due process rights deter-
5 mined appropriate by the Special Master.

6 (5) NO PUNITIVE DAMAGES.—The Special Mas-
7 ter may not include amounts for punitive damages
8 in any compensation paid under a claim under this
9 title.

10 (6) COLLATERAL COMPENSATION.—The Special
11 Master shall reduce the amount of compensation de-
12 termined under paragraph (1)(B)(ii) by the amount
13 of the collateral source compensation the claimant
14 has received or is entitled to receive as a result of
15 the events that occurred at or near the United
16 States Capitol on January 6, 2021.

17 (c) ELIGIBILITY.—

18 (1) IN GENERAL.—A claimant shall be deter-
19 mined to be an eligible individual for purposes of
20 this subsection if the Special Master determines that
21 such claimant—

22 (A) is an individual described in paragraph
23 (2); and

24 (B) meets the requirements of paragraph
25 (3).

1 (2) INDIVIDUALS.—A claimant is an individual
2 described in this paragraph if the claimant is—

3 (A) an individual who—

4 (i) served as an active duty law en-
5 forcement officer in defense of the United
6 States Capitol on January 6, 2021; and

7 (ii) suffered economic loss, non-
8 economic loss, or death as a result of the
9 attack on the United States Capitol, in-
10 cluding suicide or other death that is rea-
11 sonably attributable to the claimant’s serv-
12 ice on January 6, 2021; or

13 (B) in the case of a decedent who is an in-
14 dividual described in subparagraph (A), the per-
15 sonal representative of the decedent who files a
16 claim on behalf of the decedent.

17 (3) REQUIREMENTS.—Not more than one claim
18 may be submitted under this title by an individual
19 or on behalf of a deceased individual.

20 **SEC. __06. PAYMENTS TO ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS FOR**
21 **DEATH OR INJURY.**

22 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
23 date on which a determination is made by the Special Mas-
24 ter regarding the amount of compensation due a claimant
25 under this title under **【section __05(b)】**, the Special Mas-

1 ter shall authorize payment to such claimant of the
2 amount determined with respect to the claimant.

3 (b) **MINIMUM PAYMENT AMOUNTS FOR DEATH.**—In
4 the case of any claim payable under this title for death,
5 including suicide or any other death that is reasonably at-
6 tributable to the claimant's service on January 6, 2021,
7 such payment shall be not less than \$4,975,000.

8 **SEC. __07. ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS TO CLAIMANTS.**

9 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Not later than 180 days after the
10 expiration of the claim period under **[section __05(a)(3)]**,
11 the Special Master shall make a payment, in addition to
12 any payment under **[section __06]**, to each claimant who
13 served as an active duty law enforcement officer in defense
14 of the United States Capitol on January 6, 2021, whether
15 or not such claimant suffered any economic or non-
16 economic loss as a result of such service, in an amount
17 that is equal to—

18 (1)(A) \$4,975,000, plus

19 (B) the amount calculated under subsection (b),
20 divided by

21 (2) the total number of such claimants.

22 (b) **CALCULATION OF PAYMENTS MADE BY UNITED**
23 **STATES.**—Not later than 90 days after the expiration of
24 the claim period under **[section __05(a)(3)]**, the Attorney
25 General shall calculate the sum of each payment in resolu-

1 tion of a civil action or administrative claim paid by the
2 United States pursuant to a settlement agreement during
3 the period beginning January 20, 2025, and ending on
4 the date of the expiration of the claim period under [sec-
5 tion __05(a)(3)], if that civil action or administrative
6 claim is brought by a person who was convicted of an of-
7 fense related to events that occurred at or near the United
8 States Capitol on January 6, 2021, and arose from such
9 an offense (including any action or claim related to the
10 investigation, prosecution, or conviction for such an of-
11 fense).

12 **SEC. __08. PAYMENT AUTHORITY.**

13 This title constitutes budget authority in advance of
14 appropriations Acts and represents the obligation of the
15 Federal Government to provide for the payment of
16 amounts for compensation under this title.

17 **SEC. __09. REGULATIONS.**

18 Not later than 90 days after the date of enactment
19 of this title, the Attorney General, in consultation with the
20 Special Master, shall promulgate regulations to carry out
21 this title, including regulations with respect to—

22 (1) forms to be used in submitting claims under
23 this title;

24 (2) the information to be included in such
25 forms;

1 (3) procedures for hearing and the presentation
2 of evidence;

3 (4) procedures to assist an individual in filing
4 and pursuing claims under this title; and

5 (5) other matters determined appropriate by
6 the Attorney General.

7 **SEC. 10. RIGHT OF SUBROGATION.**

8 The United States shall have the right of subrogation
9 with respect to any claim paid by the United States under
10 this title.
