

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-**

**OFFERED BY MRS. DAVIS OF CALIFORNIA**

Strike section 2609 and insert the following new section:

**1 SEC. 2609. REPORTS ON SECURITY CLEARANCES.**

2 (a) CONGRESSIONAL EMPLOYEES.—Subsection  
3 (a)(1) of section 506H of the National Security Act of  
4 1947 (50 U.S.C. 3104) is amended—

5 (1) in subparagraph (B)(ii), by striking “; and”  
6 and inserting a semicolon;

7 (2) in subparagraph (C)(vii)(IV), by striking  
8 the period and inserting “; and”; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
10 paragraph:

11 “(D) the number of employees of Congress, in  
12 total and for each of the House of Representatives,  
13 the Senate, the Government Accountability Office,  
14 the Congressional Budget Office, the Library of  
15 Congress, and any other element of Congress, who—

16 “(i) held a security clearance at such level  
17 as of October 1 of the preceding year; and

1                   “(ii) were approved for a security clearance  
2                   at such level during the preceding fiscal year.”.

3           (b) PUBLIC AVAILABILITY.—Such section is further  
4 amended—

5           (1) in subsection (a)(1), in the matter pre-  
6           ceding subparagraph (A), by inserting “, and make  
7           publicly available,” after “submit to Congress”; and

8           (2) in subsection (b), by adding at the end the  
9           following new sentence: “Any such classified annex  
10          shall be made publicly available in redacted, unclas-  
11          sified form at the same time as the report pursuant  
12          to subsection (a)(1).”.

13          (c) INFORMATION RELATING TO INTELLIGENCE  
14 COMMUNITY.—

15          (1) EMPLOYEES.—Subsection (a)(1)(A) of such  
16          section is amended by inserting “, in total and for  
17          each element of the intelligence community,” after  
18          “employees of the United States Government”.

19          (2) CONTRACTORS.—Subsection (a)(1)(B) of  
20          such section is amended by inserting “, in total and  
21          for each element of the intelligence community,”  
22          after “contractors to the United States Govern-  
23          ment”.
