At the end of subtitle F of title X, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 10 VIRTUAL REALITY TECHNOLOGY PILOT PRO-
2	GRAM.
3	(a) Pilot Program.—
4	(1) In general.—Not later than 180 days
5	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
6	retary of the Air Force shall establish a pilot pro-
7	gram under which the Department of the Air Force
8	(including the Space Force) shall use virtual reality
9	technology and natural language processing for the
10	purposes of data collection and proficiency measure-
11	ment (in this section referred to as the "pilot pro-
12	gram'').
13	(2) Training under the pilot pro-
14	gram shall re-enforce existing frameworks of preven-
15	tion, such as the methodology known as "Ask, Care,
16	Excort" or "ACE", assisting unit commanders in
17	identifying areas for improvement.
18	(3) Sense of congress.—It is the sense of
19	Congress that the Air Force currently uses virtual

1	reality technology in many training areas which will
2	help control the costs associated with the pilot pro-
3	gram.
4	(b) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date
5	of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Air
6	Force shall submit to Congress a report on the results of
7	the data gathered during the pilot program.
8	(c) Funding.—
9	(1) Increase.—Notwithstanding the amounts
10	set forth in the funding tables in division D, the
11	amount authorized to be appropriated in section
12	4301 for Air Force, Operations and Maintenance,
13	Operating Forces, Medical Readiness, Line 140, is
14	hereby increased by \$9,000,000.
15	(2) Offset.—Notwithstanding the amounts set
16	forth in the funding tables in division D, the amount
17	authorized to be appropriated in section 4301 for
18	Army, Operation and Maintenance, Line 460, is
19	hereby reduced by \$9,000,000.
