3           (3) An assessment of the costs to the United  
4           States and to Ukraine if the conflict is allowed to  
5           continue for an additional 1 year, 5 years, or 10  
6           years.

7           (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)  
8           shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include  
9           a classified annex.

10          (d) BRIEFING.—Not later than 45 days after the date  
11          of the submission of the report required by subsection (a),  
12          the Secretary of Defense and the Secretary of State shall  
13          provide to the appropriate congressional committees, and  
14          other Members of Congress that wish to participate, a  
15          briefing on the United States strategy with respect to  
16          Ukraine and plans for the implementation of such strat-  
17          egy.

18          (e) LIMITATION ON FUNDS.—None of the amounts  
19          authorized to be appropriated or otherwise made available  
20          by this Act may be made available for Ukraine until the  
21          report required by subsection (a) is submitted to the ap-  
22          propriate congressional committees.

23          (f) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-  
24          FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-  
25          sional committees” means—

- 1 (1) the congressional defense committees; and
- 2 (2) the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the
- 3 House of Representatives and the Committee on
- 4 Foreign Relations of the Senate.
