

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118-10
OFFERED BY MR. DAVIDSON OF OHIO

At the end of subtitle C of title XII, add the following:

1 **SEC. __. REPORT AND STRATEGY FOR UNITED STATES IN-**
2 **VOLVEMENT IN UKRAINE.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the President, in coordi-
5 nation with the Secretary of Defense, shall develop and
6 submit to the appropriate congressional committees a re-
7 port that contains a strategy for United States involve-
8 ment in Ukraine.

9 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report required by subsection
10 (a) shall contain the following elements:

11 (1) A strategy stating the explicit United States
12 national interest at stake with respect to the conflict
13 in Ukraine, including an annex of specific objectives
14 and benchmarks to measure the success or failure of
15 continued United States involvement with respect to
16 Ukraine.

17 (2) A plan detailing a diplomatic pathway, in-
18 cluding any personnel involved in diplomatic commu-

1 nications, by which the United States can facilitate
2 a negotiated cessation of hostilities in Ukraine.

3 (3) An assessment of the costs to the United
4 States and to Ukraine if the conflict is allowed to
5 continue for an additional 1 year, 5 years, or 10
6 years.

7 (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)
8 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
9 a classified annex.

10 (d) BRIEFING.—Not later than 45 days after the date
11 of the submission of the report required by subsection (a),
12 the Secretary of Defense shall provide to the appropriate
13 congressional committees, and other Members of Congress
14 that wish to participate, a briefing on the United States
15 strategy with respect to Ukraine and plans for the imple-
16 mentation of such strategy.

17 (e) LIMITATION ON FUNDS.—None of the amounts
18 authorized to be appropriated or otherwise made available
19 by this Act may be made available for Ukraine until the
20 report required by subsection (a) is submitted to the ap-
21 propriate congressional committees.

22 (f) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-
23 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-
24 sional committees” means—

25 (1) the congressional defense committees; and

1 (2) the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the
2 House of Representatives and the Committee on
3 Foreign Relations of the Senate.
