AMENDMENT

OFFERED BY MR. DAVIDSON OF OHIO

Add at the end the following new section:

1	SEC ESTABLISHMENT OF HOUSE SELECT COM-
2	MITTEE ON HEALTHCARE.
3	(a) Establishment.—There is hereby established in
4	the House of Representatives for the One Hundred Nine-
5	teenth Congress a Select Committee on Healthcare (here-
6	inafter referred to as the "Select Committee").
7	(b) Composition.—
8	(1) Appointment of members.—The Speaker
9	shall appoint 20 Members to the Select Committee,
10	9 of whom shall be appointed after consultation with
11	the minority leader.
12	(2) Designation of Chair.—The Speaker
13	shall designate one Member of the Select Committee
14	as chair of the Select Committee.
15	(3) Vacancies.— Any vacancy in the Select
16	Committee shall be filled in the same manner as the
17	original appointment.
18	(c) Purpose.—Consistent with the functions de-
19	scribed in subsection (d), the purpose of the Select Com-
20	mittee is to investigate and propose legislative options to

improve the healthcare system of the United States, reduce healthcare debt, and improve the quality of care pro-3 vided by the healthcare system. 4 (d) Functions.— 5 (1) Interim reports.—In addition to the final 6 report required under paragraph (2), the Select Committee may report to the House or any com-7 8 mittee of the House from time to time the results 9 of its investigations, together with such detailed 10 findings and legislative proposals as it may deem ad-11 visable. 12 (2) Report.—Not later than December 31, 13 2026, the Select Committee shall issue a final report 14 to the House containing legislative reforms that 15 would result in \$200 billion in savings and reforms 16 per year with respect to the healthcare system of the 17 United States. 18 (3) No Legislative Jurisdiction.—The Se-19 lect Committee shall not have legislative jurisdiction 20 and shall have no authority to take legislative action 21 on any bill or resolution. 22 (e) PROCEDURE.—Rule XI of the Rules of the House 23 of Representatives shall apply to the Select Committee.

(f) Records; Staff; Travel; Funding.—

1	(1) Access to records of committees.—A
2	committee of the House shall cooperate with the Se-
3	lect Committee in providing access to records of the
4	committee which will support the Select Committee
5	in carrying out this section.
6	(2) Staff.—The appointment and the com-
7	pensation of staff for the Select Committee shall be
8	subject to regulations issued by the Committee on
9	House Administration.
10	(3) Detail of staff from the legislative
11	AND EXECUTIVE BRANCHES.—
12	(A) House staff.—Staff of employing
13	entities of the House or a joint committee may
14	be detailed to the Select Committee to carry out
15	this resolution and shall be deemed to be staff
16	of the Select Committee.
17	(B) EXECUTIVE BRANCH STAFF.—The Se-
18	lect Committee may request the head of any
19	Federal agency to detail, on a nonreimbursable
20	basis, any of the personnel of the agency to the
21	Select Committee.
22	(4) Use of consultants permitted.—Sec-
23	tion 202(i) of the Legislative Reorganization Act of
24	1946 (2 U.S.C. 4301(i)) shall apply with respect to
25	the Select Committee in the same manner as such

1	section applies with respect to a standing committee
2	of the House of Representatives.
3	(5) Travel.—Clauses 8(a), (b), and (c) of rule
4	X of the Rules of the House of Representatives shall
5	apply to the Select Committee.
6	(6) Funding; payments.—There shall be paid
7	out of the applicable accounts of the House of Rep-
8	resentatives such sums as may be necessary for the
9	expenses of the Select Committee. Such payments
10	shall be made on vouchers signed by the chair of the
11	Select Committee and approved in the manner di-
12	rected by the Committee on House Administration.
13	Amounts made available under this subsection shall
14	be expended in accordance with regulations pre-
15	scribed by the Committee on House Administration.
16	(g) Termination and Disposition of Records.—
17	(1) TERMINATION.—The Select Committee
18	shall terminate at the end of the One Hundred
19	Nineteenth Congress.
20	(2) Disposition of Records.—Upon termi-
21	nation of the Select Committee—
22	(A) the records of the Select Committee
23	shall become the records of such committee or
24	committees designated by the Speaker; and

1 (B) the copies of records provided to the 2 Select Committee by a committee of the House 3 under subsection (f)(1) shall be returned to the 4 committee.
