

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT**

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**OFFERED BY MR. RODNEY DAVIS OF ILLINOIS**

At the end of the resolution, insert the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . SPRINGFIELD RACE RIOT NATIONAL HISTORIC**  
2 **MONUMENT ACT.**

3 (a) **SHORT TITLE.**—This section may be cited as the  
4 “Springfield Race Riot National Historic Monument Act”.

5 (b) **DEFINITIONS.**—In this section:

6 (1) **HISTORIC MONUMENT.**—The term “Historic  
7 Monument” means the Springfield Race Riot Na-  
8 tional Historic Monument established by this sec-  
9 tion.

10 (2) **MAP.**—The term “Map” means the map en-  
11 titled “Springfield Race Riot National Memorial  
12 Proposed Boundary”, numbered 687/148588 and  
13 dated October 2018.

14 (3) **SECRETARY.**—The term “Secretary” means  
15 the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Di-  
16 rector of the National Park Service.

17 (c) **ESTABLISHMENT OF SPRINGFIELD RACE RIOT**  
18 **NATIONAL HISTORIC MONUMENT.**—

19 (1) **ESTABLISHMENT.**—

1           (A) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subpara-  
2           graph (B), there is established the Springfield  
3           Race Riot National Historic Monument in the  
4           State of Illinois as a unit of the National Park  
5           System, to preserve, protect, and interpret for  
6           the benefit of present and future generations,  
7           resources associated with the Springfield Race  
8           Riot of 1908 and its role in the formation of  
9           the National Association for the Advancement  
10          of Colored People.

11          (B) CONDITIONS.—The Historic Monu-  
12          ment shall not be established until the date on  
13          which the Secretary acquires sufficient land  
14          within the boundary of the Historic Monument  
15          to constitute a manageable unit.

16          (2) BOUNDARIES.—The boundaries of the His-  
17          toric Monument shall be the boundaries generally  
18          depicted on the Map.

19          (3) AVAILABILITY OF MAP.—The Map shall be  
20          on file and available for public inspection in the ap-  
21          propriate offices of the National Park Service.

22          (4) ACQUISITION OF AUTHORITY.—The Sec-  
23          retary may acquire any land or interest in land lo-  
24          cated within the boundary of the Historic Monument  
25          by—

1 (A) donation;

2 (B) purchase with donated funds or appro-  
3 priated funds; or

4 (C) exchange.

5 (5) AGREEMENTS.—The Secretary may enter  
6 into agreements with—

7 (A) the city of Springfield, Illinois, for the  
8 purpose of establishing and operating outside of  
9 the Historic Monument boundary facilities for  
10 administration and visitor services; and

11 (B) other public or private entities for the  
12 purposes of carrying out this section.

13 (6) ADMINISTRATION.—

14 (A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall ad-  
15 minister the Historic Monument in accordance  
16 with—

17 (i) this section; and

18 (ii) the laws generally applicable to  
19 units of the National Park System.

20 (B) MANAGEMENT PLAN.—

21 (i) DEADLINE FOR COMPLETION.—

22 Not later than 3 years after the date on  
23 which funds are first made available to the  
24 Secretary for this purpose, the Secretary  
25 shall prepare a general management plan

1 for the Historic Monument in accordance  
2 with section 100502 of title 54, United  
3 States Code.

4 (ii) SUBMISSION TO CONGRESS.—On  
5 completion of the general management  
6 plan under clause (i), the Secretary shall  
7 submit it to the Committee on Natural Re-  
8 sources of the House of Representatives  
9 and the Committee on Energy and Natural  
10 Resources of the Senate.
