Page 234, after line 21, insert the following (and re-designate the subsequent provisions accordingly):

1 **TITLE VII—SPRINGFIELD RACE**
2 **RIOT NATIONAL HISTORIC**
3 **MONUMENT**

4 **SEC. 701. SPRINGFIELD RACE RIOT NATIONAL HISTORIC**
5 **MONUMENT ACT.**

6 (a) **SHORT TITLE.**—This section may be cited as the
7 “Springfield Race Riot National Historic Monument Act”.

8 (b) **DEFINITIONS.**—In this section:

9 (1) **HISTORIC MONUMENT.**—The term “Historic
10 Monument” means the Springfield Race Riot Na-
11 tional Historic Monument established by this sec-
12 tion.

13 (2) **MAP.**—The term “Map” means the map en-
14 titled “Springfield Race Riot National Memorial
15 Proposed Boundary”, numbered 687/148588 and
16 dated October 2018.

1 (3) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
2 the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Di-
3 rector of the National Park Service.

4 (c) ESTABLISHMENT OF SPRINGFIELD RACE RIOT
5 NATIONAL HISTORIC MONUMENT.—

6 (1) ESTABLISHMENT.—

7 (A) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subpara-
8 graph (B), there is established the Springfield
9 Race Riot National Historic Monument in the
10 State of Illinois as a unit of the National Park
11 System, to preserve, protect, and interpret for
12 the benefit of present and future generations,
13 resources associated with the Springfield Race
14 Riot of 1908 and its role in the formation of
15 the National Association for the Advancement
16 of Colored People.

17 (B) CONDITIONS.—The Historic Monu-
18 ment shall not be established until the date on
19 which the Secretary acquires sufficient land
20 within the boundary of the Historic Monument
21 to constitute a manageable unit.

22 (2) BOUNDARIES.—The boundaries of the His-
23 toric Monument shall be the boundaries generally
24 depicted on the Map.

1 (3) AVAILABILITY OF MAP.—The Map shall be
2 on file and available for public inspection in the ap-
3 propriate offices of the National Park Service.

4 (4) ACQUISITION OF AUTHORITY.—The Sec-
5 retary may acquire any land or interest in land lo-
6 cated within the boundary of the Historic Monument
7 by—

8 (A) donation;

9 (B) purchase with donated funds or appro-
10 priated funds; or

11 (C) exchange.

12 (5) AGREEMENTS.—The Secretary may enter
13 into agreements with—

14 (A) the city of Springfield, Illinois, for the
15 purpose of establishing and operating outside of
16 the Historic Monument boundary facilities for
17 administration and visitor services; and

18 (B) other public or private entities for the
19 purposes of carrying out this section.

20 (6) ADMINISTRATION.—

21 (A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall ad-
22 minister the Historic Monument in accordance
23 with—

24 (i) this section; and

1 (ii) the laws generally applicable to
2 units of the National Park System.

3 (B) MANAGEMENT PLAN.—

4 (i) DEADLINE FOR COMPLETION.—
5 Not later than 3 years after the date on
6 which funds are first made available to the
7 Secretary for this purpose, the Secretary
8 shall prepare a general management plan
9 for the Historic Monument in accordance
10 with section 100502 of title 54, United
11 States Code.

12 (ii) SUBMISSION TO CONGRESS.—On
13 completion of the general management
14 plan under clause (i), the Secretary shall
15 submit it to the Committee on Natural Re-
16 sources of the House of Representatives
17 and the Committee on Energy and Natural
18 Resources of the Senate.
