5 (b) FINDINGS RELATING TO PEDIATRIC CANCER RE-
6 SEARCH.—Congress finds that pediatric cancer research—

7 (1) increases new treatments for safety and ef-
8 fectiveness;

9 (2) increases the likelihood of identifying a sec-
10 ondary cancer after treatment;

11 (3) increases survival rates for children;

12 (4) increases the identity factors that may be
13 associated with reducing risk;

14 (5) enhances our understanding of the funda-
15 mental mechanisms of cancer;

16 (6) increases survivorship research to reduce
17 the long-term adverse effects of cancer and its treat-
18 ment; and

19 (7) increases the ability to identify the likely
20 causes of pediatric cancer.

21 **SEC. 5113. TERMINATION OF TAXPAYER FINANCING OF**
22 **PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION CAMPAIGNS.**

23 (a) TERMINATION OF DESIGNATION OF INCOME TAX
24 PAYMENTS.—Section 6096 of the Internal Revenue Code

1 of 1986 is amended by adding at the end the following
2 new subsection:

3 “(d) **TERMINATION.**—This section shall not apply to
4 taxable years beginning after December 31, 2020.”.

5 (b) **TERMINATION OF FUND AND ACCOUNT.**—

6 (1) **TERMINATION OF PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION**
7 **CAMPAIGN FUND.**—

8 (A) **IN GENERAL.**—Chapter 95 of subtitle
9 H of such Code is amended by adding at the
10 end the following new section:

11 **“SEC. 9014. TERMINATION.**

12 “The provisions of this chapter shall not apply with
13 respect to any presidential election (or any presidential
14 nominating convention) after the date of the enactment
15 of this section, or to any candidate in such an election.”.

16 (B) **TRANSFER OF REMAINING FUNDS.**—

17 Section 9006 of such Code is amended by add-
18 ing at the end the following new subsection:

19 “(d) **TRANSFER OF FUNDS REMAINING AFTER TER-**
20 **MINATION.**—The Secretary shall transfer the amounts in
21 the fund as of the date of the enactment of this subsection
22 to the 10-Year Pediatric Research Initiative Fund de-
23 scribed in section 9008(i)(2), to be available as described
24 in such section and to remain so available until ex-
25 pended.”.

1 (2) **TERMINATION OF ACCOUNT.**—Chapter 96
2 of subtitle H of such Code is amended by adding at
3 the end the following new section:

4 **“SEC. 9043. TERMINATION.**

5 “The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to any
6 candidate with respect to any presidential election after
7 the date of the enactment of this section.”.

8 (c) **CLERICAL AMENDMENTS.**—

9 (1) The table of sections for chapter 95 of sub-
10 title H of such Code is amended by adding at the
11 end the following new item:

“Sec. 9014. Termination.”.

12 (2) The table of sections for chapter 96 of sub-
13 title H of such Code is amended by adding at the
14 end the following new item:

“Sec. 9043. Termination.”.

15 **SEC. 5114. COORDINATION OF NIH FUNDING FOR PEDI-**
16 **ATRIC RESEARCH.**

17 (a) **SENSE OF CONGRESS.**—The Congress encourages
18 the Director of the National Institutes of Health to over-
19 see and coordinate research that is conducted or supported
20 by the National Institutes of Health for research on pedi-
21 atric cancer and other pediatric diseases and conditions,
22 including through the 10-Year Pediatric Research Initia-
23 tive Fund.

1 (b) AVOIDING REPLICATE.—Clause (ii) of section
2 402(b)(7)(B) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.
3 282(b)(7)(B)) is amended by inserting “and shall
4 prioritize such pediatric research that does not replicate
5 existing research activities of the National Institutes of
6 Health” before “; and”.
