Page 54, add after line 2 the following:

1SEC. 11. DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS PROVISION2OF NURSING HOME CARE AND HOSPITAL3CARE AT STATE LICENSED OR CERTIFIED4RESIDENTIAL CARE FACILITIES.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 17 of
6 title 38, United States Code, is amended by adding at the
7 end the following new section:

8 "§1720H. State licensed or certified residential care 9 facilities

10 "(a) IN GENERAL.—At the request of an eligible vet-11 eran for whom the Secretary is required to provide domiciliary, nursing home, adult day health, or hospital care 12 13 under this chapter, or whom the Secretary determines is in need of such care, the Secretary may place the veteran 14 in a State licensed or certified residential care facility that 15 meets Department standards, at the expense of the United 16 17 States, pursuant to a contract or agreement entered into between the Secretary and the facility for such purpose, 18 if the cost of providing such care to such veteran through 19 such facility is less than the cost of providing such care 20

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1 to the veteran through any other available option. A vet2 eran who is placed in a such a facility under this section
3 shall agree, as a condition of such placement, to accept
4 home health services furnished by the Secretary under sec5 tion 1717 of this title.

6 "(b) ELIGIBILITY.—For purposes of this section, an
7 eligible veteran is a veteran with a service-connected dis8 ability rated at 70 percent or more disabling.

9 "(c) DEFINITION OF STATE LICENSED OR CER-10 TIFIED RESIDENTIAL CARE FACILITY.—In this section, 11 the term 'State licensed or certified residential care facil-12 ity' means any assisted living facility, basic care facility, 13 community residence, enriched housing program, home for 14 the aged, personal care home, shared housing establish-15 ment, or other similar licensed or certified facility.".

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
at the beginning of such chapter is amended by adding
at the end of the items relating to such subchapter the
following new item:

"1720H. State licensed or certified residential care facilities.".

(c) APPLICABILITY.—Section 1720H of title 38,
United States Code, shall take effect on the date of the
enactment of this Act and shall apply with respect to any
veteran who is eligible under subsection (b) of that section,
including such a veteran who, as of the date of the enactment of this Act, resides in a State licensed or certified
