Add at the end the following:

1 SEC. 4. STUDY; EFFECTIVE DATE.

2 (a) STUDY.—Not later than 12 months after the date 3 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Energy shall submit to Congress the results of a study comparing the 4 5 costs and benefits to consumers of switching to electric 6 kitchen ranges and ovens, consistent with section 7 325(0)(2)(B)(i)(II) of the Energy Policy and Conservation 8 Act (42 U.S.C. 6295(0)(2)(B)(i)(II)) and taking into con-9 sideration recently enacted incentives.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Sections 2 and 3, and the 11 amendments made by such sections, shall not take effect 12 until the date on which the Secretary of Energy submits 13 to Congress the results of the study required under sub-14 section (a) of this section.
