7       (a) ISSUANCE OF CYBERSECURITY GUIDANCE AND  
8       BEST PRACTICES.—  
9               (1) ISSUANCE.—The Director of the Cybersecu-  
10       rity and Infrastructure Security Agency of the De-  
11       partment of Homeland Security, in consultation with  
12       the Federal Election Commission, the Director of  
13       the National Institute of Standards and Technology,

1 and such other offices of the government as the Di-  
2 rector considers appropriate, shall issue—

3 (A) guidance for political committees and  
4 vendors who provide databases to such commit-  
5 tees on cybersecurity risks, including threats to  
6 the databases of such committees; and

7 (B) best practices for political committees  
8 and vendors to protect these databases from  
9 such threats.

10 (2) DEADLINE.—The Director of the Cyberse-  
11 curity and Infrastructure Security Agency of the De-  
12 partment of Homeland Security shall regularly issue  
13 updated versions of the guidance and best practices  
14 described in paragraph (1).

15 (b) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “political  
16 committee” has the meaning given such term in the Fed-  
17 eral Election Campaign Act of 1971 (52 U.S.C. 30101  
18 et seq.)

19 (c) DEADLINE.—The Director of the Cybersecurity  
20 and Infrastructure Security Agency of the Department of  
21 Homeland Security shall issue the first guidance and best  
22 practices under subsection (a) not later than 6 months  
23 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
