

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-**

**OFFERED BY MR. DELGADO OF NEW YORK**

Add at the end the following:

**1 SEC. 18. INVENTORY OF PFAS AT CORPS FACILITIES.**

2 Not later than 12 months after the date of enactment  
3 of this section, the Secretary of the Army, acting through  
4 the Chief of Engineers, shall submit to the Committee on  
5 Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Rep-  
6 resentatives and the Committee on Environment and Pub-  
7 lic Works of the Senate a report that identifies—

8 (1) each facility owned or operated by the  
9 Corps of Engineers at which there is a release or  
10 threatened release of a perfluoroalkyl or  
11 polyfluoroalkyl substance;

12 (2) the nature and extent of each such release  
13 or threatened release, including any associated po-  
14 tential pathway for human exposure to the applica-  
15 ble substance; and

16 (3) measures taken by the Secretary to control,  
17 remove, or remediate such substances, or otherwise  
18 reduce the risk of human exposure to such sub-  
19 stances.

1 **SEC. 19. PFAS CLEANUP RESEARCH.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Army, acting  
3 through the Chief of Engineers and the Hazardous Waste  
4 Research Center located at the Engineer Research and  
5 Development Center, shall, in coordination with other  
6 Federal agencies, develop innovative technologies and  
7 methodologies for the detection, treatment, and cleanup  
8 of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances associated  
9 with Federal facilities, including in groundwater associ-  
10 ated with such facilities.

11 (b) SUPPLEMENTAL WORK.—In carrying out this  
12 section, the Secretary shall, to the maximum extent prac-  
13 ticable, supplement and support work undertaken by other  
14 Federal agencies, including actions taken by the Adminis-  
15 trator of the Environmental Protection Agency pursuant  
16 to the plan published by the Administrator entitled  
17 “EPA’s Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) Ac-  
18 tion Plan”, dated February 2019, and updated by the doc-  
19 ument published by the Administrator entitled “EPA  
20 PFAS Action Plan: Program Update”, dated February  
21 2020.
