Add at the end the following:

## 1 SEC. 18. INVENTORY OF PFAS AT CORPS FACILITIES.

2 Not later than 12 months after the date of enactment 3 of this section, the Secretary of the Army, acting through 4 the Chief of Engineers, shall submit to the Committee on 5 Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Rep-6 resentatives and the Committee on Environment and Pub-7 lic Works of the Senate a report that identifies—

- 8 (1) each facility owned or operated by the
  9 Corps of Engineers at which there is a release or
  10 threatened release of a perfluoroalkyl or
  11 polyfluoroalkyl substance;
- (2) the nature and extent of each such release
  or threatened release, including any associated potential pathway for human exposure to the applicable substance; and

16 (3) measures taken by the Secretary to control,
17 remove, or remediate such substances, or otherwise
18 reduce the risk of human exposure to such sub19 stances.

## 1 SEC. 19. PFAS CLEANUP RESEARCH.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Army, acting 3 through the Chief of Engineers and the Hazardous Waste Research Center located at the Engineer Research and 4 5 Development Center, shall, in coordination with other Federal agencies, develop innovative technologies and 6 7 methodologies for the detection, treatment, and cleanup of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances associated 8 with Federal facilities, including in groundwater associ-9 10 ated with such facilities.

11 (b) SUPPLEMENTAL WORK.—In carrying out this section, the Secretary shall, to the maximum extent prac-12 ticable, supplement and support work undertaken by other 13 Federal agencies, including actions taken by the Adminis-14 trator of the Environmental Protection Agency pursuant 15 to the plan published by the Administrator entitled 16 "EPA's Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) Ac-17 tion Plan", dated February 2019, and updated by the doc-18 19 ument published by the Administrator entitled "EPA PFAS Action Plan: Program Update", dated February 20 21 2020.

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
