## Amendment to Rules Committee Print 116–45 Offered by Mr. Delgado of New York

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 SEC. \_\_\_\_. DISCLOSURE OF INTRODUCTIONS OF PFAS.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The introduction of any
3 perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substance by the owner
4 or operator of an industrial source shall be unlawful unless
5 such owner or operator first notifies the owner or operator
6 of the applicable treatment works of—

- 7 (1) the identity and quantity of such substance;
  8 (2) whether such substance is susceptible to
  9 treatment by such treatment works; and
- 10 (3) whether such substance would interfere with11 the operation of the treatment works.
- (b) VIOLATIONS.—A violation of this section shall be
  treated in the same manner as a violation of a regulation
  promulgated under subsection 307(b) of the Federal
  Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1317(b)).

- 17 (1) INTRODUCTION.—The term "introduction"18 means the introduction of pollutants into treatment
