Page 139, after line 22, insert the following:

1	SEC. 547. SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING DEPARTMENT
2	OF DEFENSE POLICY AGAINST SEXUAL AS-
3	SAULT ON ALL UNITED STATES MILITARY IN-
4	STALLATIONS.
5	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress makes the following find-
6	ings:
7	(1) Fighting in a foreign theater of war should
8	not require members of the Armed Forces to turn a
9	blind eye toward criminal perversion.
10	(2) The Department of Defense already has an
11	established policy against human trafficking.
12	(3) Department of Defense Instruction 2200.01
13	instructs members of the Armed Forces as follows:
14	"Oppose prostitution, forced labor, and any related
15	activities contributing to the phenomenon of traf-
16	ficking in persons (TIP). TIP is a violation of U.S.
17	law and internationally recognized human rights,
18	and is incompatible with DoD core values.".

1	(4) The Department of Defense also needs an
2	established policy to counter sexual abuse per-
3	petrated by foreign nationals on a United States-
4	controlled military installation, regardless of its loca-
5	tion.
6	(b) Sense of Congress.—It is the sense of Con-
7	gress that child sexual abuse is a violation of United
8	States law and internationally recognized human rights
9	and should not be conducted or condoned on any United
10	States-controlled military installation, regardless of loca-
11	tion.
