

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-2
OFFERED BY MR. DESAULNIER OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of the bill, add the following new title:

1 **TITLE IX—ROSIE THE RIVETER/**
2 **WORLD WAR II HOME FRONT**
3 **NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK**
4 **ADDITIONS**

5 **SEC. 901. ROSIE THE RIVETER/WORLD WAR II HOME FRONT**
6 **NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK ADDITIONS.**

7 (a) **SHORT TITLE.**—This Act may be cited as the
8 “Rosie the Riveter National Historic Site Expansion Act”.

9 (b) **ADDITIONS.**—The Rosie the Riveter/World War
10 II Home Front National Historical Park Establishment
11 Act of 2000 (16 U.S.C. 410ggg et seq.) is amended as
12 follows:

13 (1) In section 2(b), by adding at the end the
14 following: “Not later than 180 days after areas are
15 added to the park administratively or by Federal
16 law, the Secretary shall update the map to include
17 the added areas.”.

18 (2) By adding at the end of section 2, the fol-
19 lowing:

1 “(c) ADDITIONAL AREAS INCLUDED.—In addition to
2 areas included under subsection (b), the park shall include
3 the following:

4 “(1) The Nystrom Elementary School—The
5 Maritime Building, as listed on the National Reg-
6 ister of Historic Places.

7 “(2) Such other areas as the Secretary deems
8 appropriate.”.

9 (3) By amending section 3(e)(2) to read as fol-
10 lows:

11 “(2) OTHER PROPERTY.—Within the bound-
12 aries of the park, the Secretary may acquire lands,
13 improvements, waters, or interests therein, by dona-
14 tion, purchase, exchange or transfer. Any lands, or
15 interests therein, owned by the State of California or
16 any political subdivision thereof, may be acquired
17 only by donation. When any tract of land is only
18 partly within such boundaries, the Secretary may ac-
19 quire all or any portion of the land outside of such
20 boundaries in order to minimize the payment of sev-
21 erance costs. Land so acquired outside of the bound-
22 aries may be exchanged by the Secretary for non-
23 Federal lands within the boundaries.”.
