Amendment to Rules Committee Print 118–10 Offered by Mr. DeSaulnier of California

At the end of subtitle F of title X, add the following:

1 SEC. 1071. REPORT ON CLIMATE-RELATED RISKS TO THE 2 HEALTH OF MILITARY PERSONNEL.

3 Not later than one year after the date of enactment 4 of this Act, and annually thereafter, the Secretary of De-5 fense shall submit to the congressional defense committees 6 a report on climate-related risks and associated potential 7 health issues for military personnel. Such report shall—

8 (1) identify climate-related risks and associated 9 potential health issues for military personnel, includ-10 ing hazards associated with extreme heat, tropical 11 diseases and other diseases that could be exacer-12 bated by climate change, floods, wildfires, and air 13 pollution; and

(2) provide recommendations to increase the
ability of the Department of Defense to reduce such
climate-related risks and the occurrence of such associated potential health issues.
