Strike sections 1 and 2 and insert the following (and redesignate section 3 as section 2):

1 SECTION 1. APPLICATION OF PAYGO ACT SEQUESTRATION.

(a) APPLICATION.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, with respect to carrying out a sequestration order under the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010 first issued after the date of enactment of this Act, before any other direct spending program (including Medicare programs described in section 256(d) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985) is reduced under such order, the budgetary resources of the direct spending programs described in subsection (b)—

(A) shall be reduced in the order such

(A) shall be reduced, in the order such provisions are listed in such subsection, in an amount equal to the amount of any reduction required, but for this section, for Medicare programs under section 6 of the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010; and

1	(B) after the reduction required under sub-
2	paragraph (A), shall be further reduced, in the
3	order such provisions are listed in such sub-
4	section, by the amount (if any) of the remaining
5	budget-year debit as determined under such
6	section 6.
7	(2) RESUMPTION OF PAYGO ACT SEQUESTER.—
8	After the reductions required by paragraph (1), such
9	sequestration order shall be carried out with respect
10	to direct spending programs (excluding such Medi-
11	care programs) consistent with the requirements of
12	the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010.
