1	SEC. 28 REPORT ON ACCELERATION OF MILITARY POS-
2	TURE IN THE UNITED STATES INDO-PACIFIC
3	COMMAND.
4	(a) Short Title.—This section may be cited as the
5	"Report on Acceleration of Military Posture in the Indo-
6	Pacific Act of 2025" or the "RAMP-INDOPACOM Act
7	of 2025".
8	(b) In General.—Not later than 180 days after the
9	date of the enactment of this section, the Commander of
10	the United States Indo-Pacific Command
11	(USINDOPACOM) shall submit to the congressional de-
12	fense committees a report on options available to the Com-
13	mander to accelerate regional posture initiatives that in-
14	cludes the following:
15	(1) A comprehensive list of planned or ongoing
16	projects carried out by the Commander to establish
17	or enhance the access of the Armed Forces to the
18	Indo-Pacific region, including headquarters, military

1	installations, prepositioned stocks, and forward oper-
2	ating locations.
3	(2) For each project included on the list under
4	paragraph (1)—
5	(A) the location of the project; and
6	(B) an expected timeline for the full com-
7	pletion of each listed initiative, including major
8	milestones through 2027, 2030, and 2035.
9	(3) A description of any opportunities to accel-
10	erate each such project to advance the operational
11	use of such project.
12	(4) An analysis of the specific impediments, in-
13	cluding financial, diplomatic, or logistical, to expe-
14	diting each project, along with recommendations, in-
15	cluding required resources, to overcome barriers and
16	reduce timelines.
17	(5) An evaluation of the operational and stra-
18	tegic benefits of accelerating the completion timeline
19	of each such project.
20	(6) A prioritized listing of candidate projects
21	and locations suitable for acceleration and the re-
22	sources or actions required to advance the relevant
23	timetable for completion.
