Add at the end the following:

1	SEC Flexibility for States and Localities
2	Findings — State and local governments across the
3	country have a better understanding of the needs of their
4	citizens than Congress. Allowing states and local
5	governments to allocate infrastructure funds will lead to a
6	more efficient use of those funds.
7	Policy Statement.— It is the policy of this
8	concurrent resolution on the budget that Congress must
9	provide funds to states without restricting how states
10	allocate their infrastructure spending. Except that funds
11	may not be used to make contributions to any
12	underfunded pension plan, or to increase the salaries of
13	government officials.
