

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 6172
OFFERED BY MR. DAVIDSON OF OHIO

Add at the end of title IV the following:

1 **SEC. 409. ANNUAL REPORT ON DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS RE-**
2 **LATING TO AUTHORITY UNDER FISA.**

3 Section 603 of the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance
4 Act of 1978 (50 U.S.C. 1873) is amended—

5 (1) by redesignating subsection (e) as sub-
6 section (f); and

7 (2) by inserting after subsection (d) the fol-
8 lowing new subsection (e):

9 “(e)(1) Not later than March 1 of each year, the Di-
10 rector of National Intelligence, in coordination with the
11 Attorney General and the Director of the National Secu-
12 rity Agency, shall submit to the Committee on the Judici-
13 ary and the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence
14 of the House of Representatives and the Committee on
15 the Judiciary and the Select Committee on Intelligence of
16 the Senate a report on disciplinary actions taken against
17 an employee of the United States Government relating to
18 mishandling of information acquired under this Act in vio-
19 lation of this Act, an order of the Foreign Intelligence Sur-

1 veillance Court, or regulations, guidance, or administrative
2 requirements issued pursuant to this Act.

3 “(2) Each report under paragraph (1) shall include,
4 with respect to the year covered by the report, the fol-
5 lowing:

6 “(A) The total number of violations described
7 in paragraph (1) that occurred.

8 “(B) A description of each specific violation de-
9 scribed in such paragraph that occurred.

10 “(C) With respect to each such violation—

11 “(i) whether any corresponding disciplinary
12 action was taken and the result of that discipli-
13 nary action, including each termination of an
14 employee by reason of such violation;

15 “(ii) whether such violation resulted in a
16 criminal charge, and the result of that criminal
17 charge; and

18 “(iii) if no corresponding disciplinary ac-
19 tion was taken, the reasons no such action was
20 taken.

21 “(3) The first report submitted under paragraph (1)
22 shall cover, in addition to the year covered by the report,
23 violations described in such paragraph that occurred be-
24 fore such year.”.
