## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 116–19 OFFERED BY MR. DEFAZIO OF OREGON

At the appropriate place in subtitle G of title XII, insert the following:

1	SEC. 12 MODIFICATION TO DEFINITIONS IN THE WAR
2	POWERS RESOLUTION.
3	Section 8(c) of the War Powers Resolution (50
4	U.S.C. 1547) is amended to read as follows:
5	"(c) For purposes of this joint resolution—
6	"(1) the term 'United States Armed Forces'—
7	"(A) has the meaning given the term
8	'armed forces' in section 101 of title 10, United
9	States Code; and
10	"(B) includes all civilian personnel of the
11	Department of Defense;
12	"(2) the term 'hostilities' means a situation
13	where any of the following acts are taking place, re-
14	gardless of whether the United States Armed Forces
15	are directly participating in such attacks, the ex-
16	change of fire, or bombardment:
17	"(A) The conduct of attacks or exchange
18	of fire between regular or irregular military
19	forces.

1	"(B) The aerial, naval, or ground bom-
2	bardment of, or other conduct of attacks
3	against, military or civilian targets by regular
4	or irregular military forces.
5	"(C) The deployment of the United States
6	Armed Forces for defensive or offensive oper-
7	ations.
8	"(D) Any situation where there exists an
9	imminent threat that any act described in sub-
10	paragraph (A), (B), or (C) will take place.
11	"(3) the term 'imminent' means a situation
12	where the use of force by the United States Armed
13	Forces is instant, overwhelming, and leaving no
14	choice of means and no moment for deliberation;
15	and
16	"(4) the term 'introduce' means—
17	"(A) any commitment, engagement, de-
18	ployment, or other involvement of the United
19	States Armed Forces in hostilities, including
20	the taking of self-defense measures by the
21	Armed Forces in response to an attack or
22	threat of attack;
23	"(B) the assigning or detailing of members
24	of the United States Armed Forces to com-
25	mand, coordinate, participate in the movement

1	of, accompany, provide intelligence, or provide
2	logistical support or training for any foreign,
3	regular or irregular, military or police forces if
4	those foreign forces are involved in hostilities
5	(regardless of whether those hostilities involve
6	insurgent forces or the military forces of a for-
7	eign country); or
8	"(C) the assigning or detailing of any
9	member of the United States Armed Forces to
10	an operation authorized by the United Nations
11	Security Council under chapter VII of the



United Nations Charter.".
