Add at the end of title XI the following:

1 **SEC. 11 ____ . PURCHASE OF RETIRED HANDGUNS BY FED-**
2 **ERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the
4 date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator of Gen-
5 eral Services shall establish a program under which a Fed-
6 eral law enforcement officer may purchase a retired hand-
7 gun from the Federal agency that issued the handgun to
8 such officer.

9 (b) LIMITATIONS.—A Federal law enforcement offi-
10 cer may purchase a retired handgun under subsection (a)
11 if—

12 (1) the purchase is made during the 6-month
13 period beginning on the date the handgun was so re-
14 tired;

15 (2) with respect to such purchase, the officer
16 has passed a background check within 30 days of
17 purchase under the national instant criminal back-
18 ground check system established under the Brady
19 Handgun Violence Prevention Act; and

1 (3) with respect to such purchase, the officer is
2 in good standing with the Federal agency that em-
3 ploys such officer.

4 (c) COST.—A handgun purchased under this section
5 shall be sold at the fair market value for such handgun
6 taking into account the age and condition of the handgun.

7 (d) SENSE OF CONGRESS ON USE OF FUNDS.—It is
8 the sense of Congress that any amounts received by the
9 Government from the sale of a handgun under this section
10 should be transferred and used to fund evidence-based gun
11 violence prevention or gun safety education and training
12 programs.

13 (e) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

14 (1) the term “Federal law enforcement officer”
15 has the meaning given that term in section
16 115(c)(1) of title 18, United States Code;

17 (2) the term “handgun” has the meaning given
18 that term in section 921(a) of title 18, United
19 States Code; and

20 (3) the term “retired handgun” means any
21 handgun that has been declared surplus by the ap-
22 plicable agency.
