

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT  
FOR H.R. 5  
OFFERED BY MR. POLIS OF COLORADO**

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 802. LIMITATION.**

2       Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act or  
3 the amendments made by this Act, the amendments made  
4 by section 121(2) to the Elementary and Secondary Edu-  
5 cation Act of 1964 (20 U.S.C. 6301 et seq.) shall not take  
6 effect until the date on which the Secretary of Edu-  
7 cation—

8           (1) determines that striking title IV of Elemen-  
9 tary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20  
10 U.S.C. 7901), as such Act was in effect on the day  
11 before the date of enactment of the Student Success  
12 Act, from such Act (20 U.S.C. 6301 et seq.) will not  
13 result in a lowering of academic standards for stu-  
14 dents with disabilities through overreliance on alter-  
15 nate assessments aligned to alternate achievement  
16 standards; and

17           (2) provides written notification to Congress on  
18 such determination.
