3 (a) STUDY.—The Secretary of Defense shall conduct
4 a study to determine whether—

- 5 (1) character of discharge and reenlistment
 6 codes are assigned equitably among all members;
 7 and
- 8 (2) the status of members of the Armed Forces 9 as members of a protected class under title VII of 10 the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Pub. L. 88-352; 42 11 U.S.C. 2000e et seq.) increases the likelihood of dis-12 charge of such members under conditions other than 13 honorable.

(b) REPORT.— Not later than 90 days after the date
of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense
shall submit a report to the congressional defense committees regarding the results of the study under subsection
(a).

(c) ELEMENTS.—The report under subsection (b) 1 2 shall compare, with regard to minority members and other members during calendar years 2008 through 2017, the 3 following: 4 5 (1) The character of discharge members receive 6 upon separation from the Armed Forces. 7 (2) The types of reenlistment codes members 8 receive. 9 (3) Any other information the Secretary deter-10 mines appropriate to understand any disparity 11 among the characters of discharge members of dif-12 ferent races receive upon separation from the Armed 13 Forces. 14 (4) If the Secretary determines that members 15 described in subsection (a)(2) are more likely to re-

16 ceive a discharge under conditions other than honor-17 able than other members of the Armed Forces—

18 (A) reasons the Secretary determines why19 such disparity exists; and

20 (B) whether substantially similar infrac21 tions result in consistent conditions of discharge
22 and reenlistment codes.

23 (d) ONLINE PUBLICATION.—The Secretary shall24 publish the report online not later than 15 days after sub-
