

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 7147**OFFERED BY MR. EDWARDS OF NORTH CAROLINA**

Insert, at the appropriate place in the bill, the following:

1 SEC. _____. (a) Subparagraph (P) of section
2 101(a)(15) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8
3 U.S.C. 1101(a)(15)(P)) is amended—

4 (1) in clause (iii)(II), by striking “or” at the end;

5 (2) by redesignating clause (iv) as clause (v);

6 (3) in clause (v), as redesignated by subparagraph
7 (B), by striking “clause (i), (ii), or (iii)” and inserting
8 “clause (i), (ii), (iii), or (iv)”; and

9 (4) by inserting after clause (iii) the following:

10 “(iv) seeks to enter the United States
11 temporarily and solely for the purpose of
12 performing functions that are integral and
13 essential to the operation of a mobile en-
14 tertainment provider (as set forth in sec-
15 tion 214(c)(4)(I)(ii)); or”.

16 (b) Paragraph (4) of section 214(c) of the Immigra-
17 tion and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1184(c)(4)) is amend-
18 ed by adding at the end the following:.

1 “(I) The following shall apply to the ad-
2 mission of any alien under section
3 101(a)(15)(P)(iv):

4 “(i) The mobile entertainment pro-
5 vider shall be subject to the same program
6 requirements that govern the admission of
7 non-immigrants pursuant to section
8 101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(b) of the Immigration
9 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)
10 (15)(H)(ii)(b)) as promulgated by the De-
11 partment of Labor in section 655 of title
12 20 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

13 “(ii) For purposes of section
14 101(a)(15)(P)(iv), functions that are inte-
15 gral and essential to the operation of a mo-
16 bile entertainment provider include trans-
17 porting, assembly, operation, disassembly,
18 and maintenance of mobile entertainment
19 attractions, structures, and equipment, in-
20 cluding rides, games, novelties, and food or
21 beverage concessions, as well as other func-
22 tions that are common in the mobile enter-
23 tainment industry and are necessary for
24 the safe and efficient operation of the mo-
25 bile entertainment provider.

1 “(iii) For purposes of this subpara-
2 graph, the term ‘mobile entertainment pro-
3 vider’ means—

4 “(I) a carnival or circus that
5 travels around the United States on a
6 temporary or seasonal basis; or

7 “(II) a provider of services nor-
8 mally affiliated with a carnival or cir-
9 cus, such as food and game conces-
10 sions, that travels around the United
11 States on a seasonal or temporary
12 basis to provide services to State,
13 county, and local fairs and festivals,
14 or support events sponsored by not-
15 for-profit organizations for fund-
16 raising.”.

17 (c) Not later than 180 days after the date of the en-
18 actment of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security
19 and the Secretary of Labor shall separately publish in the
20 Federal Register proposed rules implementing the provi-
21 sions of this section and the amendments made by this
22 section, and shall finalize such rules not later than 1 year
23 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
