Amendment to Rules Committee Print 119–3 Offered by Ms. Elfreth of Maryland

At the end of title II, add the following new section:

1 SEC. _____. PRESERVATION OF HISTORICAL ITEMS.

2 None of the funds made available by this title may
3 be obligated or expended to destroy or censor any histor4 ical artifact or document on the basis of ideology until—

5 (1) the artifact or document has been reviewed
6 by a panel of experts who represent—

7 (A) the Historian of each Armed Force; 8 (B) the Society for Military History; and 9 (C) the Company of Military Historians; 10 (2) such panel concurs with the determination 11 to destroy or censor the artifact or document; and 12 (3) 90 days after the date on which the Sec-13 retary concerned (as such term is defined in section 14 101 of title 10, United States Code) submits to Con-15 gress written notice of such destruction or censor-16 ship.
