Page 5, line 4, before “Effective” insert “(a) RE-  
SCISSION.—”.

Page 5, after line 10, insert the following new sub-  
section:

1           (b) IDENTIFICATION OF AMOUNTS SUBJECT TO POS-  
2 SIBLE RESCISSION.—

3           (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Housing  
4 and Urban Development has allocated funding to the  
5 States, including city, county, and municipal govern-  
6 ments, under the 3rd round of funding for the  
7 Neighborhood Stabilization Program, as set forth in  
8 paragraph (2). Amounts from the allocations set  
9 forth in paragraph (2) of this subsection will be sub-  
10 ject to possible rescission and cancellation, to the ex-  
11 tent provided in subsection (a).
