

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 444
OFFERED BY MR. ELLISON OF MINNESOTA

At the end of the bill add the following:

1 **SEC. 4. JOBS AND GROWTH IMPACT OF BUDGETS.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—If the House Budget Resolution
3 for fiscal year 2014, the Senate Budget Resolution for fis-
4 cal year 2014, or the President’s budget for fiscal year
5 2014 results in a net spending cut for fiscal year 2014
6 relative to the Congressional Budget Office’s Alternative
7 Fiscal Scenario, then the House Budget Committee Chair,
8 the Senate Budget Committee Chair, or the President, re-
9 spectively, shall submit a supplemental budget pursuant
10 to subsection (b).

11 (b) CONTENTS OF SUPPLEMENTAL UNIFIED BUDG-
12 ET.—If the House Budget Committee Chair, the Senate
13 Budget Committee Chair, or the President is required to
14 submit a supplemental unified budget under subsection
15 (a), such unified budget shall be submitted to Congress
16 not later than April 1, 2013, and shall include an estimate
17 of the employment and economic growth impact of the
18 Budget, relative to the Congressional Budget Office’s Al-

1 ternative Fiscal Scenario, for calendar years 2013 and
2 2014.
