

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 754, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. ELLISON OF MINNESOTA**

At the end of the bill, add the following new title:

1 **TITLE V—OTHER MATTERS**

2 **SEC. 501. SENSE OF CONGRESS RELATING TO THE OPER-**
3 **ATION AGAINST OSAMA BIN LADEN.**

4 It is the sense of Congress that—

5 (1) President Barack Obama and the intel-
6 ligence community deserve the respect and praise of
7 all Americans for their efforts in carrying out the in-
8 telligence-related aspects of the recent operation
9 against Osama bin Laden in Abbottabad, Pakistan;
10 and

11 (2) the intelligence community is committed to
12 fighting terrorism and is not fighting a war against
13 any religion, including Islam, as Presidents George
14 W. Bush and Barack Obama have stated repeatedly,
15 including—

16 (A) shortly after the terrorist attacks upon
17 the United States on September 11, 2001,
18 when President Bush stated that “Americans
19 understand that we fight not a religion. Ours is
20 not a campaign against the Muslim faith.”; and

1 (B) after the death of Osama bin Laden,
2 when President Obama said that “the United
3 States is not – and never will be – at war with
4 Islam.”.
