AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-8 OFFERED BY MR. ELLZEY OF TEXAS

At the end of subtitle E of title V add the following new section:

SEC. 5 . DIRECTOR OF ADMISSIONS OF THE UNITED 2 STATES NAVAL ACADEMY. 3 Chapter 853 of title 10, United States Code, is amended by inserting after section 8451a the following 5 new section: "§ 8451b. Director of admissions 7 "(a) Establishment and Appointment.—There is a director of admissions of the Naval Academy. The director of admissions shall be appointed by the President, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, and shall perform such duties as the Superintendent of the Naval 11 Academy may prescribe with the approval of the Secretary 13 of the Navy. 14 "(b) Grade.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), a person appointed as director of admissions of the Naval Academy has the regular grade of commander in the Navy or lieu-

tenant colonel in the Marine Corps.

1	"(2) A person serving as director of admissions shall
2	have the regular grade of captain in the Navy or colonel
3	in the Marine Corps upon the earlier of—
4	"(A) the date on which such person completes
5	six years of service as the director of admissions;
6	and
7	"(B) the date on which such person would have
8	been promoted had the person been selected for pro-
9	motion from among officers in the promotion zone.
10	"(c) Detail.—The President may detail any officer
11	of the Navy or the Marine Corps in a grade above lieuten-
12	ant or captain, respectively, to perform the duties of direc-
13	tor of admissions without appointing the officer as director
14	of admissions. Such a detail does not affect the position
15	of the officer on the active-duty list.".
