At the end of subtitle G of title XII, add the following:

1	SEC PROGRAM TO PREVENT, MITIGATE, AND RESPOND
2	TO CIVILIAN HARM AS A RESULT OF MILI-
3	TARY OPERATIONS IN SOMALIA.
4	(a) Program Required.—
5	(1) In general.—Not later than 180 days
6	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
7	retary of Defense, in coordination with the Secretary
8	of State, shall develop and implement a program—
9	(A) to prevent, mitigate, and respond to ci-
10	vilian harm resulting from military operations
11	to counter al-Shabaab or the Islamic State in
12	Somalia (ISIS-Somalia); and
13	(B) to enhance the ability for Somali civil-
14	ians to report instances of civilian harm result-
15	ing from—
16	(i) any operations conducted by
17	United States Armed Forces; and
18	(ii) any operations in which United
19	States Armed Forces provided operational

1	support to the Somali Army or the African
2	Union Mission in Somalia (AMISOM).
3	(2) COORDINATION.—The program required by
4	this subsection shall be carried out in accordance
5	with—
6	(A) section 1213 of the National Defense
7	Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2020 (Public
8	Law 116–92);
9	(B) section 936 of the John S. McCain
10	National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal
11	Year 2019 (10 U.S.C. 134 note); and
12	(C) section 1057 of the National Defense
13	Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2018.
14	(b) Scope of Program.—The program required by
15	subsection (a) shall include the following:
16	(1) Measures in accordance with section 1057
17	of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal
18	Year 2018 to improve the ability of the Somali Na-
19	tional Army, AMISOM, the United States military,
20	and United States contractors to prevent, mitigate,
21	and respond to instances of civilian harm as a result
22	of military operations to counter al-Shabaab or
23	ISIS-Somalia.
24	(2) Measures in accordance with section 1057
25	of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal

1	Year 2018 and section 936 of the John S. McCain
2	National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year
3	2019 (10 U.S.C. 134 note) to improve coordination
4	among international actors involved in military oper-
5	ations in Somalia, to include AMISOM, with regard
6	to preventing and mitigating civilian casualties, and
7	collecting data and reporting on such incidents when
8	they occur.
9	(3) Specific measures relating to compliance by
10	Somalia with section 936(b)(3) of the John S.
11	McCain National Defense Authorization Act for Fis-
12	cal Year 2019 (10 U.S.C. 134 note), to include
13	measures to ensure that Somali civilians, including
14	those without reliable access to the internet, and
15	credible local or international nongovernmental orga-
16	nizations, can report civilian harm, including death,
17	injury, or damage to civilian infrastructure, resulting
18	from United States operations and partner oper-
19	ations; and
20	(4) Measures to ensure that ex gratia payments
21	and other assistance are made available as appro-
22	priate in accordance with section 1213 of the Na-
23	tional Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year
24	2020 (Public Law 116–92).
25	(c) Report.—

1	(1) In general.—Not later than 1 year after
2	the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
3	of Defense, in coordination with the Secretary of
4	State, shall submit to the appropriate congressional
5	committees a report on the measures that have been
6	taken to implement the program required by sub-
7	section (a).
8	(2) FORM.—The report required by this sub-
9	section shall be submitted in unclassified form, but
10	may include a classified annex.
11	(d) Definitions.—In this section:
12	(1) Appropriate congressional commit-
13	TEES.—The term "appropriate congressional com-
14	mittees" means—
15	(A) the Committee on Armed Services and
16	the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House
17	of Representatives; and
18	(B) the Committee on Armed Services and
19	the Committee on Foreign Relations of the Sen-
20	ate.
21	(2) OPERATIONAL SUPPORT.—The term "oper-
22	ational support" means training, advising, com-
23	manding, coordinating, participating in the move-
24	ment of, or accompanying Somali Army or AMISOM
25	forces, providing such forces with medevac or other

- 1 medical aid, aerial refueling, intelligence, surveil-
- 2 lance, or reconnaissance, or close air support for op-
- 3 erations.
