## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118– 10

## OFFERED BY MS. ESCOBAR OF TEXAS

At the end of subtitle F of title X, insert the following:

SEC. 10 REPORT ON COST AND TIME BURDENS IM-
POSED ON MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES
DUE TO LACK OF ADEQUATE COMMERCIAL
FLIGHT SERVICES TO NEXT STATION FOR
TRAINING OR PERMANENT CHANGE OF STA-
TION MOVES.
Not later than May 1, 2024, the Secretary of Defense
shall submit to the congressional defense committees a re-
port on the burdens, in both cost and time, imposed on
members of the Armed Forces and their families who are
traveling from their station for training or for permanent
change-of-station moves using commercial airlines and air-
ports when direct flights are not available between an air-
port close to the location of the base where they are sta-
tioned and an airport close to the location to which they
need to travel. Such report shall include—
(1) an assessment of the average time a mem-
ber of the Armed Forces is likely to spend in transit

1	when traveling by commercial air, aggregated by ac-
2	tive duty and reserve status, to address rural and
3	suburban installations;
4	(2) an assessment of the average cost to a
5	member of the Armed Forces of commercial air
6	transit when traveling to their next station for train-
7	ing or for a permanent change-of-station move, ag-
8	gregated by active duty and reserve status, to ad-
9	dress rural and suburban installations;
10	(3) a list of the 15 largest active military instal-
11	lations in the continental United States;
12	(4) an overview of commercial airline accessi-
13	bility to the military installations on the list required
14	by paragraph (3);
15	(5) an overview of commercial airline accessi-
16	bility from such military installations to the United
17	States capital, especially as it pertains to military
18	families; and
19	(6) recommendations that could make such
20	military installations more accessible by commercial
21	air transport, particularly when local airports may
22	be in closer proximity to such an installation, includ-
23	ing accessible to and from the United States capital
24	to enable members of the Armed Forces and their
25	families to sustain trips to bolster quality of life and
