**OFFERED BY MS. ESCOBAR OF TEXAS**

Add at the end of subtitle G of title XXVIII, the following new section:

1 **SEC. 28\_\_ . ASSESSMENT OF THE USE OF INTERGOVERN-**  
2 **MENTAL SUPPORT AGREEMENTS FOR UN-**  
3 **SPECIFIED MINOR MILITARY CONSTRUCTION**  
4 **PROJECTS.**

5 (a) **REPORT REQUIRED.**—Not later than 120 days  
6 after the date of the enactment of this section, each cov-  
7 ered Assistant Secretary shall submit to the congressional  
8 defense committees a report assessing the potential use  
9 of intergovernmental support agreements (as defined in  
10 section 2679 title 10, United States Code) to carry out  
11 unspecified minor military construction projects under  
12 section 2805 of title 10, United States Code.

13 (b) **ELEMENTS.**—The report required under sub-  
14 section (a) shall include the following:

15 (1) An assessment of the feasibility of applying  
16 revised maximum dollar thresholds for unspecified  
17 minor military construction projects carried out

1 under intergovernmental support agreements as fol-  
2 lows:

3 (A) \$15,000,000 for laboratory revitaliza-  
4 tion projects

5 (B) \$12,000,000 for projects carried out  
6 using amounts from the Operation and Mainte-  
7 nance account.

8 (2) A list of not more than 10 projects included  
9 in a facilities investment plan or facility support pro-  
10 gram of a military department that could be carried  
11 out under intergovernmental support agreements.

12 (c) COVERED ASSISTANT SECRETARY DEFINED.—In  
13 this section, the term “covered Assistant Secretary”  
14 means—

15 (1) the Assistant Secretary of the Army for In-  
16 stallations, Energy, and Environment;

17 (2) the Assistant Secretary of the Navy for En-  
18 ergy, Installations, and Environment; and

19 (3) the Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for  
20 Installations, Environment, and Energy.
